Dan Savadove Returns To Station Management

The longtime Philly resident has reemerged as the President/CEO of Philadelphia-based Main Line Broadcasting, which today purchased Dame Broadcasting's WCHA, WHAG, WDLD, WIKZ & WQCM/Hagerstown, MD for \$22.5 million.

Savadove is best known in the radio industry for his former role as CEO of Root Communications, which two years ago sold its 26 stations to Qantum Communications Corp. for \$82 million. He's also headed the operations of such stations as WIOQ (Q102)/Philadelphia. At Main Line, Arlington Capitol has signed on as a venture capital partner.

With the sale, the Al Dame-led Dame Broadcasting lowers its stable of properties to eight stations, all of which are located in central Pennsylvania. Michael J. Bergner of Bergner & Co. was the exclusive broker in this transaction.
